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Financial Commitment

- Ambassadors are required to pay the program fee once admitted into the program in September.
- Ambassadors are responsible for securing their own technology and access to Wifi, Google Classroom, Youtube, and Zoom for engagement in the online classroom and synchronous sessions.
- Ambassadors are strongly encouraged to attend/present at the NBASLH Convention.
*Ambassadors are responsible for all fees associated with attending the NBASLH Convention, including registration, lodging, transportation meals, etc.

Time Commitment & Scheduling

- Outside of the Cultural Humility Conference, all synchronous sessions will be scheduled with ambassadors using a scheduling poll. Sessions are typically held on weekday evenings (i.e. Thursdays 7-9pm EST).
- Ambassadors are required to meet all deadlines for asynchronous assignments, as noted in the syllabus.
- Ambassadors will spend time engaging in asynchronous activities, synchronous sessions, and creating video reflections.
- Using a cohort style format, ambassadors will spend time engaging and responding to fellow ambassadors in the online classroom

Earning CEUs

- Ambassadors are expected to fully participate in each aspect of the program, culminating in earning approximately 25 CEUs.
- CEUs for asynchronous activities are earned through the timely completion of critical-self reflection activities in the online classroom.
- CEUs for synchronous activities are earned through attendance and engagement in scheduled virtual events.

A Commitment to Lifelong Learning: Beyond the Program

Upon completion of the Cultural Humility Ambassador Program, ambassadors will be invited to engage in a lifelong learning community. They may choose to co-facilitate future ambassador programming or serve on the NBASLH Cultural Humility Task Force. It is expected for ambassadors to personally commit to the values of cultural humility, apply the cultural humility lens to their spheres of influence and/or work settings, and engage in advocacy and leadership activities to advance equity, inclusion, and justice in the profession and beyond.
